

- 4. Mediterranean**














Why agriculture does matter for biodiversity?




- More than $\frac{1}{2}$ of the total land area (landscape)

- More than $\frac{1}{2}$ of the agriculture area is abandoned
- Some 20% of NATURA 2000 are agric. habitats




- ❖ **1% of UAA**


